This technique is easy and creates unexpected beauty on handstamped cards.



Your cards will vary depending on how much color you apply to the rubber, the amount of water mist, the texture of the paper, and your own style of stamping.

## WATER MISTING TECHNIQUE

1. Choose a design with a flat rubber surface. Hero Arts Real Flowers and Shadow Stamps® are especially good choices.
2. "Paint" directly onto rubber using ink cubes and your fingertip or paint wheel and brush. Use one or more shades of a color for a blended effect.
3. Mist rubber with water and stamp onto paper. Mist again and stamp for a lighter impression.

TIP: Use bamboo and split pen pigment color cubes on flower stems.
